

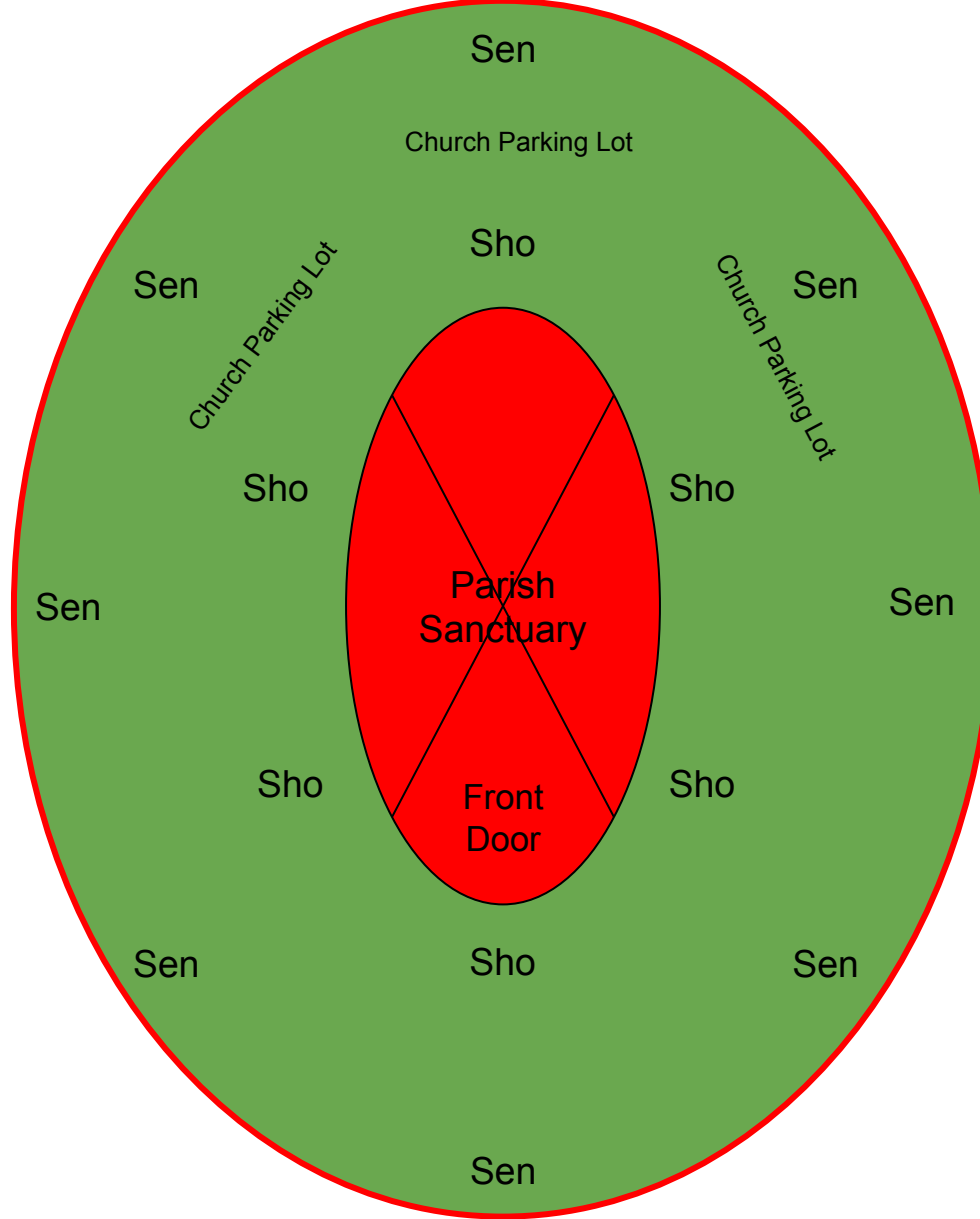
1- Think backwards from the worst to the best case scenario.

2- Expect the dangerous person to be SOF-trained with accomplices, eager to shoot, engage in vandalism, non-verbal and verbal insults and harassment, irrational and obscene speech, and hateful invective.

3- Expect the dangerous person and accomplices to carry and use military-grade knives, chemicals, and explosives.

5- Maintain passive video surveillance 24/7.



# Parish Posture During Parish Functions

1- Start and maintain police and church multimedia records on the dangerous person and accomplices.

2- Alert police to this or whatever preventative plan is adopted.

3- Distro intel including images, bios, and behaviors of the dangerous person and accomplices to church leaders, police, and sentinels and shooters.

4- The Bishop should request police/court restraining/harassment order against the dangerous person and accomplices.

5- Sentinels and shooters should open carry a handgun and a Dakota Alert M538-HT MURS or equivalent.

6- Shooters should open carry a long gun.

7- Parishioners owning a valid concealed carry permit should carry at parish functions and all should be prepared to phone-video activity.
